Keep your garden tidy

Overgrown lawns, litter, food and pet waste can increase the chances of pests in or near your home.



Check your window restrictors

These stop windows opening too far so accidents can be avoided. If they're missing or broken, please contact Pinnacle to arrange for them to be fitted or fixed.



Turn off your water when away

Hot weather can cause burst pipes so locate your stopcock and turn the water off while you're away.

Stock condition surveys

DIO has commissioned Jones Lang LaSalle (JLL) to continue the Stock Condition Survey on an additional 1,000 UK SFA homes across 20 sites from July to September 2025. The homes selected will be of different types, age and condition. If your home is selected, you will receive a notification letter from JLL at least 2 weeks before the intended date of the inspection, requesting your availability to allow the surveyor access to your property. The surveys will take a maximum of 1 hour.

We greatly appreciate your cooperation where you are able to provide access to your property, as this will allow the surveyor to successfully carry out the survey and inform a detailed assessment of the condition of each home. Please note your home will not be selected if you have already taken part in a previous survey (from January 2025).

FAMCAS results released

The results of the 2025 Tri-service Families Continuous Annual Survey (FAMCAS) show a steady increase of satisfaction with accommodation services.

The survey, which captures information on the attitudes and experiences of Service families, includes the following results:

- Over half of Service families (51%) are satisfied with the overall standard of SFA/SSFA, an increase from 47% in 2024.
- Satisfaction with the response rate for repairs is now 36%, an increase of 10% since last year.
- Satisfaction with the quality of repairs has also increased to 33% from 26% in 2024.


This steady increase in satisfaction is an encouraging sign that Service families are starting to experience the improvements that DIO and its suppliers are making in the delivery of accommodation services. We will continue to work to improve the SFA experience for Service families.

Planning for move-ins/outs and removals this summer

Book your pre-move-out appointment with your Housing Officer as soon as you apply for your next SFA (at least 30 working days ahead of your scheduled move-out date).

We have extended the time to complete a pre-move-out appointment from 14 to 30 working days, allowing more time for you to receive advice on moving-out and guidance to prepare your house to meet the move-out standard.

Changes to the ORS Survey

Opinions Research Services (ORS) have been commissioned to conduct monthly surveys on behalf of DIO. The telephone surveys, which are answered by Service Personnel and their families, will provide DIO with a better understanding of the views and experiences of people living in UK SFA.

Respondents are chosen randomly each month, and the survey can be completed by the Service Person or their partner. Anonymised results are sent to DIO on a monthly basis and offer invaluable insights that will shape decisions that seek to improve the experience of those residing in SFA.

From 1 July 2025, the survey question set has been updated to better align with the nationally recognised <u>Tenant Satisfaction Measures</u>, making it easier to compare the level of service provided in SFA against sector-wide housing standards. While new themes have been incorporated, many questions remain unchanged, and the survey still includes questions that are specifically tailored to capturing the unique nature of Service life.

DIO is committed to using the insights gained from this survey to accelerate continuous improvement, and we look forward to sharing key findings and planned actions, directly informed by your feedback. Find out more on the Defence Homes website.
